## H. CONSENT CALENDAR:

It was moved by Mayor Pro Tem Alves, seconded by Council Member Mills and carried 4-0 (Council Member Hails absent) that the items on the Consent Calendar be approved as presented.

- 5. Discussion of COVID-19 status and review the need to continue the state of emergency established by Resolution 2020-12 due to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) for another 60 days.

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- 6. Adopt Resolution 2021-26 correcting Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Rate and Fee Schedule Impact Fees.
- 7. Authorize the City Administrator's previous contract approval with National Demographic Corporation (NDC) of Glendale, California to provide demographer services for the required redistricting process in the amount of \$2,500; and approve a budget amendment and appropriate \$11,750 from the General Fund (104) to cover increased costs for the redistricting process (\$11,250 for increase cost for NDC and \$1,000 for publication and website services for a total cost of \$14,750).

## I. INDIVIDUAL BUSINESS ITEMS

- 1. Public Hearing for the City's annual public accounting for development impact fees for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 pursuant to State Law, Government Code Section 66006. Finance Director Rainbow Moore provided a PowerPoint presentation highlighting the annual public account for development impact fees for Council's review and consideration. Mayor Sally opened the public hearing at 7:14 p.m., receiving no comment, closed the public hearing at 7:14 p.m. Following discussion, it was moved by Mayor Pro Tem Alves, seconded by Council Member Mills and unanimously carried to receive and file the 2020-2021 Impact Fee Report as required by Government Code Section 66006.
- 2. Approve the formation of Landscape and Lighting Assessment District 21-01 and adoption of Resolution 2021-27 accepting the Engineer's Report for The Grove No. 1 Landscape and Lighting Assessment District for Subdivision 06-02 located west of Belmont Road between Chestnut Avenue and the westerly extension of Firebaugh Avenue. City Engineer Lisa M. Wallis-Dutra provided a report for Council's review and consideration. Following discussion, it was moved by Council Member Hails, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Alves and unanimously carried to authorize the formation of Landscape and Lighting Assessment District 21-01 and adopt Resolution 2021-27 as presented.
- 3. Adopt Resolution 2021-28 to authorize the City Administrator to submit applications to receive funding for Per Capita Park grant in the amount of \$177,952. Finance Director Rainbow Moore provided a PowerPoint presentation highlighting the Per Capita Park grant for Council's review and consideration. Council posed questions and Public Works Director Daymon Qualls provided a response thereto. City Administrator Adam Ennis provided additional comments for Council's consideration. Following discussion, it was moved by Council Member Garver, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Alves and unanimously carried to adopt Resolution 2021-28 as presented.

Council Member Garver and Council Member Hails reported they attended the recent Tooleville meeting. Mayor Pro Tem Alves reported that the November TCAG meeting was cancelled and that he recently participated as a Judge for the Ms. Exeter contest.
